Welcome To Ventura County

Ventura County is one of 58 counties in the State of California. It has a beautiful, temperate climate and its landmass rises from sea level to 8,831 feet at Mt. Pinos in the Los Padres National Forest. At certain times of the year, it is possible to stand on the beach and see snow in the mountains. The county's coastline stretches a stunning 42 miles. Together, farming and the Los Padres National Forest occupy half of the county's 1.2 million acres. The mild Mediterranean climate, along with scenic geography, makes the area attractive to the more than 900,000 culturally and ethnically diverse people who call Ventura County home.

The cities include Camarillo, Fillmore, Moorpark, Ojai, Oxnard, Port Hueneme, Santa Paula, Simi Valley, Thousand Oaks, and San Buenaventura (Ventura) Ventura County has a strong economic base that includes major industries such as biotechnology, health care, education, agriculture, advanced technologies, oil production, military testing and development, and tourism. Home to two universities (California State University Channel Islands and California Lutheran University), a small private college and three community colleges (Oxnard, Ventura, and Moorpark), and multiple university extensions, the county is an educational center and enjoys a strong structure for workforce development.

Simi Valley is the third largest of Ventura County's ten cities with an estimated population of 126,380. Located just 40 miles from downtown Los Angeles, which puts you close to everything the City of Angels has to offer.


Simi Valley also allows residents to enjoy a quieter life with all the benefits the larger surrounding area provides up and down the coast. Simi Valley ranks much lower than the national average in property crimes, violent crimes, and overall crime. In 2022, it was ranked 21 among the 50 safest cities in California, and the crime rate is 70% lower than the California average.

One more thing you might want to know about Simi Valley: It's been ranked as the <u>fifth happiest city in the US</u>, according to a study by the University of Vermont. - Substance use, including drugs and alcohol, is strictly prohibited.
- Maintaining peak physical fitness throughout the season is a requirement.
- Respect towards volunteers, staff, and the community is non-negotiable.
- Regular participation in community events is compulsory for all players.

• The Ventura Vikings will actively project a positive presence within the Blind River community. This entails participating in charity events, visiting schools, and engaging in various community events. 

Luc has been the Hockey Director at Ventura Mariners Youth Program since 2001. He has also served as a Skills and Conditioning Coach for the NHLPA. Luc coached the California Titans from 2012 to 2017, achieving NAPHL Championships in 2010 and 2012 with the 18AAA team. Notably, he has coached current NHL players Trevor Moore and Phoenix Copley, both now with the L.A. Kings. As a player, he enjoyed a fourteen-year professional career, earning awards such as the Murrayfield Racer Most Valuable Player in 1998 and multiple MVP awards with the Tulsa Oilers, including being the CHL leading scorer in 1997.
