Attunement is another key part of learning for children. In a child's daily home life, experience, exploration, and interactions are teaching them. As a parent, your connection to your child affects how and what they learn because their developing nervous system is attuned to yours. It's like a Bluetooth signal that is always on. When your child is not with you, this system looks to other adults for these cues. Some are better than others at establishing this vital connection for their safety and learning, which can result in learning struggles at school.

For interventions to be effective, they must be attuned to a child's unique needs; grounded in safety and interest. I have spent 30 years learning how to help provide attuned and dynamic learning experiences. By focusing on strengths and addressing skills gaps together, we can discover that learning can feel good. Hard work can become rewarding. Learning is a natural part of life, and we all need to feel capable of learning well.

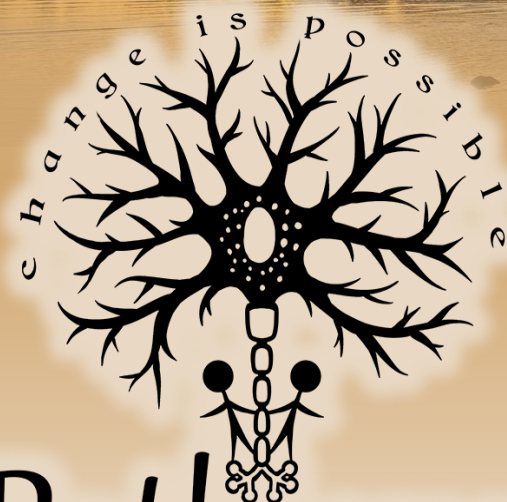
