MINUTES from 2021

Smith Baptist Association Semi-Annual Meeting • January 24, 2021 Friendly Baptist Church, Tyler, Texas

The 122nd meeting of the Smith Baptist Association opened with Carmen Price, Worship Leader for the TJC BSM, leading the congregation in “How Great is Our God.” Rev. Steve Lyles, the Executive Pastor of Friendly Baptist Church, followed the opening song, read Romans 12:12. It reads as follows: “Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer.” Rev. Lyles welcomed the messengers and guests attending in person and the “online” viewers to the meeting.

Following another song by Carmen Price, Rev. Scott Parrish, Vice-Moderator for SBA, recognized the messengers present and seated them for voting purposes. Two new churches were realized – Whitehouse Baptist Fellowship joined on January 13, 2020, and Iglesia Bautista de Fellowship joined 2-19-2020. Four new pastors were recognized: Dr. Gil Lain, Bethel Baptist Church; Rev. Scott Miles, FBC Owentown; Rev. Jason White, Colonial Hills Baptist Church; and Rev. Joshua Fala, Lone Star Church.

Mark Jones, Director for Collegiate Ministry with Texas Baptists; Tim Watson, Director of Area 7, Texas Baptists; and Wayne Livingston, Field Ministry Strategist with Southern Baptist of Texas, were recognized as Special Guests.

Rev. Ryan Surratt, Treasurer, Presented the following Treasurer’s Report for December 2020. It reads as follows:

The Balance Sheet for the month ending December 31, 2020, shows a Current Operating Fund balance of \$10,468.56. The November 30 balance was \$9,946.21. The current Savings Fund for the Operating account is \$20,363.48.

The Analysis of Revenues & Expenses for the month shows an Income of \$24,536.60, which HAS DECREASED from the November Income Receipts, which was \$19,052.55. The monthly revenues are ABOVE the budget forecast of \$20,838.75. From last month to this month, there was an INCREASE in receipts of \$5,484.05.

The total expenses were \$24,014.25, which is MORE than the total revenues, and MORE than November expenses, which were \$23,758.74. The total net operating results for the month was an operational EXCESS of \$522.35.

With there being no questions, the report was unanimously approved.

Rev. Jack Newton brought a motion from the Administrative Team on the Officers’ Nomination and approval for 2021. Motion carried. He then directed the messengers to the list of Timberline Board of Directors. Again, he made the motion to approve the list as printed. Motion carried.

The program was turned over to Joe Osteen, BSM Director, UT Tyler, and Reagan Reid, BSM Director, Tyler Jr. College. Students participating in the program were Amber Bader, UTT BSM Associate Director; Josie Katenkamp and Jared White, Students Leaders, UTT BSM; and BSM Campus Missionary Interns: Shelby Wood, Ian Brommers, Yemile Flores, Chris Williams, and Hunter Marsh. They gave the messengers and guests a summary of the 2020 BSM focus for COVID 19. They also offered a glimpse into 2021 plans. There are 39 people at UT Tyler, 31 at TJC, and five at Trinity Valley Community College in leadership for the BSM. The Renew and Focus Groups have 11 attending their weekly small group meetings and 180 attending large group gatherings. In 2020 their Mission emphasis involved 14 with Go Now; 31 at Mission A; 19 to New Orleans with TJC; and 66 served at Beach Reach with UT Tyler. There have been 16 students saved during this past year.

30 have gotten involved in weekly evangelism training. Through a series of transition steps, the BSM Discipleship pathway leads a student from the first contact to graduation. They prepare, pray, engage, equip, disciple, and mobilize. By the time a student graduates, they can be a disciple-maker in a new context and do long-term missions, CMI, serving through a local church.

Following the program’s conclusion, Dr. Danny Pickens, Director of Missions, gave a brief report on the Association and coping with COVID 19. He expressed his appreciation to Joe and Reagan for the BSM program and thanked the SBA churches for their continued support of the BSM through Smith Association. He asked for constant prayers for churches and the Association as we face uncertain times with the pandemic and political challenges.

Dr. Pickens called on Dr. Kelly Burton, Pastor of FBC Alba, to close the meeting in prayer. Out of an abundance of caution, the Annual Meeting was held virtually as well as “in person.” Attending in person were approximately 65 people. The “virtual” attendance is unknown.

**Smith Baptist Association Semi-Annual Meeting
July 12, 2021
Southside Baptist Church, Tyler, Texas**

Dr. Mark Price, the pastor of Southside Baptist Church, opened the meeting with the song “I Love to Tell the Story.” The congregation joined in singing the hymn. Dr. Price told the group that the meeting was to encourage everyone to do missions. He stated that we have been given the Great Commandment to “Go into all the world and teach the Gospel, baptizing them in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.” Matthew 28:19-20.

Following the prayer Rev. Scott Parrish, Moderator, called the meeting to order. Rev. Parrish continued to introduce the new pastors and staff of Smith Baptist Association. He had the messengers stand and be recognized to vote on any business conducted at the meeting.

They were as follows: Dr. Andrew O’Kelley, Pastor of Calvary Baptist, Tyler; Dr. Michael Gossett, Sr. Pastor of Green Acres Baptist, Tyler; Dr. Aaron Glover, Pastor of FBC Troup; and Dr. Tim Brown, Pastor of FBC Whitehouse. Other staff changes included Rev. Steve Alberts, Connections Pastor of Colonial Hills, Tyler. Rev. Alberts was the former Youth Pastor and moved to this new position.

Special Guests attending the meeting were Wayne Livingston, Field Representative E2, Southern Baptist of Texas; Dowell Loftis, Director, Center for Ministerial Health, Texas Baptists; and Preston Cave, Missions and Discipleship Coordinator, Texans on Mission.

Rev. Ryan Surratt, Treasurer, Presented the following Treasurer’s Report for June 2021. It read as follows:

Treasurer’s Report, June 2021

The Balance Sheet for the month ending June 30, 2021, shows a Current Operating Fund balance of \$9,575.76. The prior month’s balance was \$11,968.02. The current Savings Fund for the Operating account is \$17,370.25. Both the checking and savings accounts have decreased since last month.

The Analysis of Revenues & Expenses for the month shows an Income of \$17,472.20, which HAS DECREASED from May’s Income Receipts, which was \$23,178.00. The monthly revenue is BELOW the budget forecast of \$20,666.67. From last month to this month, there was a DECREASE in receipts of \$5,705.80.

The total expenses were \$21,864.46, which is MORE than the total revenues but LESS than the prior month’s expenses which were \$24,880.54. The total net operating result for the month was an operating LOSS of \$4,392.26. However, year-to-date income has a surplus of \$6,113.97 which works out to a \$1,019 surplus per month of excess income received over expenses.

With there being no questions, the report was unanimously approved.

Ryan Surratt asked Danny and Paula Pickens to come to the stage following the Financial Report. Ryan explained that Danny is celebrating his 20th year as the Director of Missions of Smith Baptist Association, and Paula is celebrating her 10th year as his assistant. He further explained that under the direction of the Administrative Team, the churches of SBA were contacted and asked to contribute to a love offering for the Pickens. Ryan presented a love offering amounting to little over \$5200.00 to them to express the Association’s appreciation of a job well done and wishes for many more years to follow. Danny and Paula graciously accepted the gift and gave God credit for the opportunity to serve, as Danny stated, “the best Association in the state of Texas.”

Moderator Parrish turned the program over to Brandy Meadows, the SBA GA Leader. Brandy has served as the G.A. Director of SBA for ten years. She stated that this year’s summer camp at Timberline had 150 girls, and the Mini Camp in the Spring had 100 girls. She educated the messengers on the fact that the G.A.s had flexible literature. Her goal is to teach the girls that they can be missionaries everywhere they go. “They do not necessarily have to go to a foreign land. They can serve right here in their back yard,” stated Brandy. She further said that she had made one of the best friends she could ever have. Stephanie Greer is also a G.A. leader and helps with the camps and other events throughout the year. Stephanie brought her three daughters (Carley, Avery, and Lily Green),

who are all in the G.A. program. The life verse that is encouraged for the G.A.s is Micah 6:8, “He has told you, O man, what is good; and what does the LORD require of you but to do justice, and to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your God?” C.H. Ford and Kirk Acheson followed the G.A. update with an update from the R.A.s. This September, C. H. Ford has worked with the R.A.s for 50 years. The WMU started the Royal Ambassadors in 1908. Mary Hill Davis made the motion to start the program. Since 1883 boys have been doing “mission things.” C.H. encouraged the men and women because R.A.s help makes “Big men out of little boys.” Kirk Acheson, with his helper Ben Roach took over the R.A. leadership following the death of Jeff Palmer. Kirk told the group that Jay had mentored him for three years before taking charge of SBA RA leadership. This year is full of exciting events: R.A. Frisbee Golf Tournament, Super Saturday with the pine car derby, R.A. Camp July 26-30, and R.A. Mini Camp July 30-August 1st. He said he would be happy to help any church get the R.A. program started.

Preston Cave and Josh Price from the Texans on Mission with the Texas Baptist Men came and spoke regarding possible mission opportunities for churches with people who cannot go on mission trips. He brought several handouts with ideas of how to do missions from home. He encouraged anyone to contact him, and he would be happy to speak at their church and help organize an event. With the newly organized Texas Baptist Men, the goal is to contact the churches and make them aware of how Texans on Missions can help them do mission work.

Danny Pickens again thanked the churches and the Administrative Team for the love offering. He said that God had truly blessed Smith Baptist Association over the past 20 years, and he believed the reason for it was that the churches made missions the main objective. “The churches of SBA work together to fulfill our purpose statement, “reaching and equipping our member churches in to fulfill the Great Commission.” Danny thanked the Texas Baptist Men for providing the dinner catered by Spring Creek BBQ. He also expressed appreciation to Southside Baptist Church for graciously hosting this meeting.

Dr. Tim Brown of FBC Whitehouse closed the meeting in prayer.

There were 130 people in attendance representing 31 churches and organizations.

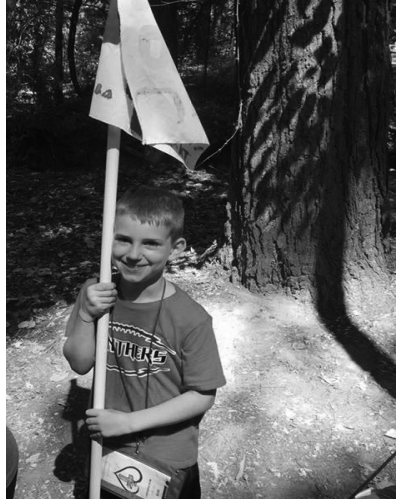

COMMUNITY MISSIONS

Ten SBA churches received the Community Missions Grant this year. They are as follows: FBC Hawkins; Noonday Baptist Church; FBC Alba; Mt. Carmel Baptist Church; Lone Star Church; Primera Iglesia Bautista; Faith Baptist Church, Tyler; The Cross Iglesia Bautista de Fellowship; and St. Paul Baptist Church.

FBC Hawkins used the funds to help feed approximately 80 BSM students at UT Tyler. Noonday Baptist Women’s Ministry provided sacks with apples, oranges, bananas, candy, cookies, and a New Testament Tract. The Noonday Food Pantry gave out the bags, thus helping approximately 200 needy families. FBC Alba used their grant to help with yard work, serve local government housing residents, and VBS follow-up. Mt. Carmel Baptist in Whitehouse used their assistance for VBS June 21-25, 2021. Lone Star Church hosted an Easter Outreach for Eagle Creek Community which included an egg hunt and devotions/skits for everyone. They also set up a prayer tent to help others know about God.

Primera Iglesia Bautista used the post-covid time as an opportunity to try something new and flexible. Parents and kids alike were welcomed at their first Block Party held in the church parking lot. Faith Baptist Church in Tyler distributed backpacks to the neighborhood children to prepare for school. The Cross Baptist Church used their grant to reignite and relaunch their church into the community with training and worship experience. Iglesia Bautista de Fellowship Mission Church gave 100 pairs of shoes as community outreach to the Hispanic families that are not attending church. The event was held in September. This outreach event provided the church with a list of un-churched families in their community. Last but not least, St. Paul Baptist Church in Jacksonville held its annual back-to-school bash for kids in the community. They provided backpacks, school supplies, food, and prayer for the families in their community.

We did not shut our doors and tried to find ways to have groups but most opted out of camps and retreats for most of 2020 and through the spring of 2021. We were blessed to have Texas Baptist Men come out in April and complete many projects for us and be an overall blessing to us. But then summer 2021 came and what a summer it was! We didn't reach our pre-covid attendance but we stayed busy and had a good number of groups. It was also, without a doubt, one of the most difficult summers we have experienced. We definitely felt the pain of facilities that had been largely unused in a year and a half and we also struggled to find enough summer staff to meet our needs. But we also experienced God working in amazing ways to help us through it and for lives to still be impacted by His grace and love. We made it through the summer with only a very little interruption from

covid and we can look back and be proud of the ministry that happened.

So, we are alive but definitely still in recovery mode. We are in great need of Churches and individuals to join us. We NEED those that love Timberline and the ministry that we have had and will continue to have to come along side of us financially. Gifts of any size are wonderful and you can even set up to be a monthly donor right through our website(timberlinecamp.com) but we love one-time gifts as well. We also need for people to pray for us. Please pray that God would continue to use us for His glory to impact the lives of kids and adults that come through our gates. Constitution

Approved January 27, 2008, SBA Annual Meeting, FBC Tyler

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this body shall be Smith Baptist Association, Inc.

ARTICLE II - DENOMINATIONAL COOPERATION

The Association shall cooperate with Baptist entities of like faith and practice, and hold fraternal correspondence with sister associations and conventions, as the messengers of the Association may deem proper.

ARTICLE III - STATEMENT OF CHRISTIAN BELIEFS

The general statement of faith for the Association is any edition of the Baptist Faith and Message, adopted by the Southern Baptist Convention.

ARTICLE IV - PURPOSE AND CORE VALUES

Purpose

The Smith Baptist Association exists to equip and serve member churches in Christian fellowship and in fulfilling the Great Commission.

Values

*Loving Spirit, *Cooperation, *Autonomy, *Unity, *Diversity, *Innovation, *Accountability, *Fellowship

ARTICLE V - MEMBERSHIP

Section 1

The Association shall be comprised of duly elected Messengers from Baptist Churches cooperating with the Statement of Christian Beliefs set forth herein. Such cooperation shall include an attitude sympathetic with the purposes and work of the Association, financial support of the work, and participation in Associational activities.

Section 2

Each church shall be entitled to four Messengers and one additional Messenger for each fifty members above one hundred to a maximum of twelve Messengers

Section 3

Acceptance of Messengers from petitioning churches shall be upon the recommendation of the Administrative Team to the Advisory Council and upon acceptance of such recommendation by the Messengers at any Regular Meeting of the Association.

ARTICLE VI - MEETINGS

Section 1

The Association shall meet in Regular Meetings two times a year in January and July at a time and place to be decided upon by the Advisory Council.

Section 2

The Advisory Council may, when necessary, call Special Meetings. Notice of Special Meetings with the intended agenda, must be in possession of every cooperating church and messengers no later than the Saturday prior to said meeting. Notice may be given by regular mail, e-mail, or telephone. The agenda for Special Meetings is restricted to the agenda distributed in the notification.

Section 3

The Association shall use Roberts Rules of Order Revised to conduct all meetings and business transactions in those meetings.

Section 4

All meetings, Regular and Special, shall be called to order by the Moderator or Vice-Moderator. If neither is present the Clerk shall act as temporary presiding officer.

ARTICLE VII - OFFICERS

Section 1

The officers of the Association shall be as follows: Moderator, a Vice-Moderator, a Clerk, and a Treasurer, all of who shall also serve as corporate officers for the Association.

Section 2

The Nominating Committee shall present a slate of candidates for the positions of Moderator, Vice-Moderator, Clerk, and Treasurer at the January meeting each year.

After accepting any nominations from the floor, the Moderator will call for a vote. If there are no nominations from the floor, the slate of candidates proposed by the Nominating Committee may be declared by the Moderator to be elected by acclamation. Should there be nominations from the floor for any position, each position will be voted upon separately by a voice-vote.

Section 3

A simple majority vote shall be required to elect officers. After the first vote, if no one candidate receives a majority of the votes cast, a second vote shall be taken with only the two candidates receiving the most votes

Section 3

The Association shall use Roberts Rules of Order Revised to conduct all meetings and business transactions in those meetings.

Section 4

All meetings, Regular and Special, shall be called to order by the Moderator or Vice-Moderator. If neither is present the Clerk shall act as temporary presiding officer.

ARTICLE VII – OFFICERS

Section 1

The officers of the Association shall be as follows: Moderator, a Vice-Moderator, a Clerk, and a Treasurer, all of who shall also serve as corporate officers for the Association.

Section 2

The Nominating Committee shall present a slate of candidates for the positions of Moderator, Vice-Moderator, Clerk, and Treasurer at the January meeting each year. After accepting any nominations from the floor, the Moderator will call for a vote. If there are no nominations from the floor, the slate of candidates proposed by the Nominating Committee may be declared by the Moderator to be elected by acclamation. Should there be nominations from the floor for any position, each position will be voted upon separately by a voice-vote.

Section 3

A simple majority vote shall be required to elect officers. After the first vote, if no one candidate receives a majority of the votes cast, a second vote shall be taken with only the two candidates receiving the most votes on the first vote on the ballot. After the second vote, if no majority is received by either candidate, the presiding officer shall cast the deciding vote.

Section 4

The presiding officer for such meeting shall be as designated in Article VI, Section 4.

Section 5

Each duly elected officer shall take office at the conclusion of the Meeting when he or she is elected and will serve for a period of twelve (12) months, through the corresponding Regular Meeting of the next year.

Section 6

Should any office become vacated, successor candidates shall be nominated by the Nominating Committee and presented at the next Meeting of the Association. Nominations may also be received from the floor. Upon receiving a majority vote, candidates will fulfill the unexpired term of office.

Section 7

The Moderator, Vice-Moderator, and Treasurer shall be limited to two consecutive years of service.

Section 8

The Moderator and Director of Missions shall be ex-officio members of the Advisory Council and any appointed committees and/or task forces.

ARTICLE VIII – STAFF

Section 1

The Director of Missions as elected by the Association will serve as the chief executive officer of the corporation. He will be responsible for the overall ministry of the Association as outlined in a job description approved by the Messengers at a Regular Meeting. The job description will include but not be limited to meeting with the Administrative Team, the Advisory Council, and the Church Messengers.

Section 2

The Director of Missions will seek to determine needs of the member churches each year through interviews, surveys, visits, and other means. The Director of Missions, with the input of the Advisory Council, and the help of staff, ministry assistants and task force teams, will strive to meet and/or resolve any determined needs through planning and conducting ministry as necessary to do so.

Section 3

The Director of Missions in conjunction with the Administrative Team will recommend the hiring of necessary staff and administrative assistants to conduct the ministry of the Association. The Church Messengers shall approve hiring of said personnel at a Regular or appropriately called Special Meeting.

ARTICLE IX – ORGANIZATION

The organizational structure of the Association shall consist of the Advisory Council, The Administrative Team and Task Force Teams appointed as necessary to efficiently and expeditiously fulfill the Mission Statement and Strategic Priorities of the Association.

Section 1

The Advisory Council shall be comprised of the officers of the Association and no less than six individuals elected at large from the Association to represent the member churches.

- A. The Advisory Council shall meet a minimum of six times a year.
- B. The function of the Advisory Council is as outlined in the By-Laws of the Association.

Section 2

The Administrative Team shall be comprised of nine members.

- A. The Administrative team shall meet monthly.
- B. The function of the Administrative team is as out-lined in the By-Laws of the Association.

Section 3

Task Force Teams may be appointed or dismissed upon recommendation from the Advisory Council and/or the Director of Missions as deemed necessary to conduct the ministry of the Association.

- A. Teams shall meet as needed to carry out the task appointed to them.
- B. The function of Task Force Teams is as outlined in the By-Laws of the Association.
- C. Auxiliaries
 - 1. African-American Fellowship of Smith Baptist Association -This auxiliary works within the framework of the Smith Baptist Association to aid in ministry to African American pastors and churches. Events are coordinated with the calendar of SBA. In the event that funding is necessary, a request will be presented to the Administrative Team for approval. This auxiliary is to be staffed by volunteers, unless otherwise approved by the Administrative Team.
 - 2. Iglesias Bautistas Unidas of Smith Baptist Association -This auxiliary works within the framework of the Smith Baptist Association to aid in ministry to Hispanic pastors and churches. Events are coordinated with the calendar of SBA. In the event that funding is necessary, a request will be presented to the Administrative Team for approval. This auxiliary is to be staffed by volunteers, unless otherwise approved by the Administrative Team.

ARTICLE X – POWERS AND DUTIES

Section 1

The Association recognizes the autonomy of each member church and disclaims any ecclesiastical authority over any member church.

Section 2

The Association may not withdraw fellowship from any church without due cause. In order for the Association to withdraw fellowship, a complaint must be made against the offending church. That complaint will be reviewed by the Administrative Ministry Team. A report of its findings will be presented at the next Regular or appropriate called Special Meeting at which time the Messengers will determine if any action should be taken. A two-thirds (2/3) majority vote of the recognized Messengers present will be required to withdraw fellowship from any member church.

ARTICLE XI – ANNUAL REPORTS

It shall be the duty of each member church to provide an Annual Church Profile to the Association.

ARTICLE XII – AMENDMENTS

Section 1

The Constitution may be amended by presenting changes at the July Meeting and receiving a minimum of a two-thirds vote of duly elected Messengers at the January Meeting. All amendments will require a two-thirds majority of duly elected Messengers present and voting to be enacted.

Section 2

The By-Laws may be amended at any Regular or appropriately called Special meeting. All amendments to the By-Laws will require a two-thirds majority of those members present and voting to be enacted.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

1. The Board of Directors for Timberline Camp and Conference Center will be nominated by the Nominating Committee, approved by the Church Messengers, and serve on a three-year rotating basis.
2. The Chairperson for the Advisory Council shall be named by the Nominating Committee.
3. The Director of Missions will make reports and recommendations for ministry to the Advisory Council.

I. ADVISORY COUNCIL

Responsibilities

The Advisory Council will ensure that strategy planning remains up to date, especially in the areas of missions, budgeting and calendar planning; recommend Associational officers; receive suggestions and coordinate plans from the DOM and Task Force Teams; make recommendations to the Messengers; appoint Task Force Teams to meet specific or temporary needs; assist the DOM in planning the January and July meetings of the Association.

Comprised of: Moderator, Vice Moderator, Clerk, Treasurer, Association Representatives. **

Total Members: Six elected members (plus officers of the Association)

Each elected representative shall serve three years before rotating off the council for a minimum of one year. After one year the person may be nominated to serve again.

II. ADMINISTRATIVE TEAM

Responsibilities

This Team will oversee the administrative functions of the Association, including personnel, annual budgeting, finances, plans and policies, properties, credentials, endowment, and other administrative functions necessary for the operation of the Association. Appoint a Nominating Committee and name the chairperson for the committee.

Comprised of: Nine members

Each member serves three years before rotating off the team for a minimum of one year. After one year the person may be nominated to serve again.

III. TASK FORCE TEAMS

Responsibilities:

Task Force Teams will be formed to focus on areas of need within the Association such as: Missions, Education, Training, Fellowship, Publicity and others as deemed necessary. Task Force Teams will present a written and oral report to the Advisory Council at each meeting. Task Force Teams are to keep the Director of Missions currently informed of their work.

Comprised of: Teams will be formed of sufficient size to carry out assigned tasks.

IV. NOMINATING COMMITTEE

Responsibilities

This committee has the responsibility of presenting the Association at each January meeting a proposed slate of candidates for the following offices: Moderator, Vice-Moderator, Treasurer, Clerk, and Associational Representatives to the Advisory Council.

This committee has the responsibility of presenting to the Association at each January and July meeting recommendations for expiring terms and other vacancies on the Administrative Ministry Team and the Advisory Council. This committee is to name the Chairperson of the Advisory Council and the Administrative Team each year. Recommendations from this committee will be brought to the Advisory Council for review and discussion. No fewer than six individuals from this list will be presented to the Messengers to be voted on at the next Regular or Special Meeting.

Comprised of: Nine Members

Each member serves three years before rotating off the committee for a minimum of one year. After one year the person may be nominated to serve again.
