

Funds will be available until November 1, 2022, or until the account has been depleted, whichever comes first.

Grants are awarded on the second Monday of each month at the Administrative Team Meeting as long as the funds are available.

Dr. Brandon Holiski, the pastor of Southern Oaks Baptist Church, will be teaching a class on **Hermeneutics** (Interpreting the Bible) this fall semester through Midwestern Baptist Theological Seminary (Spurgeon College). The course is scheduled for Tuesday evenings. I've set it up with three levels of engagement, which allows

people to take it for credit (toward their Contextualized Leadership Development Certifications or even Advanced Standing at MBTS) or simply for personal enrichment, with a range of commitments. Essentially that means:

Level 1: Attend Lectures (no credit)

Level 2: Attend Lectures and do some supplemental (and lay-friendly) assigned reading (no credit)

Level 3: Attend Lectures and do all assignments (credit)

Best of all, it is FREE! (except for the books for Levels 2 and 3).

It would be great for people interested in working towards a certificate in theological studies or planning on attending seminary in the future (especially at MBTS, but also other SBC seminaries) or those heading into vocational ministry. But it is also great for those who are leaders in the church (e.g., Sunday School teachers, small group leaders, elders, etc.) or lay people who desire to be better equipped at reading the Bible well.
