


A Word from Dr. Danny...

The maximum amount awarded is \$350.00.

Funds are available until account balance is depleted.

A portion of the SBA budget and a special grant from the Mary Hill Davis Offering has been designated to be available to cooperating churches for local mission projects. Any SBA church may apply once a year for one specific project to be completed within the Smith Baptist Association for evangelism. This application must be completed and submitted by email. The Administrative Team will review each application. You will receive a notification of the decision regarding your request following the Team meeting. The maximum amount of any grant will not exceed \$350.00. Grants are awarded on the second Monday of each month at the Administrative Team Meeting as long as the funds are available.
