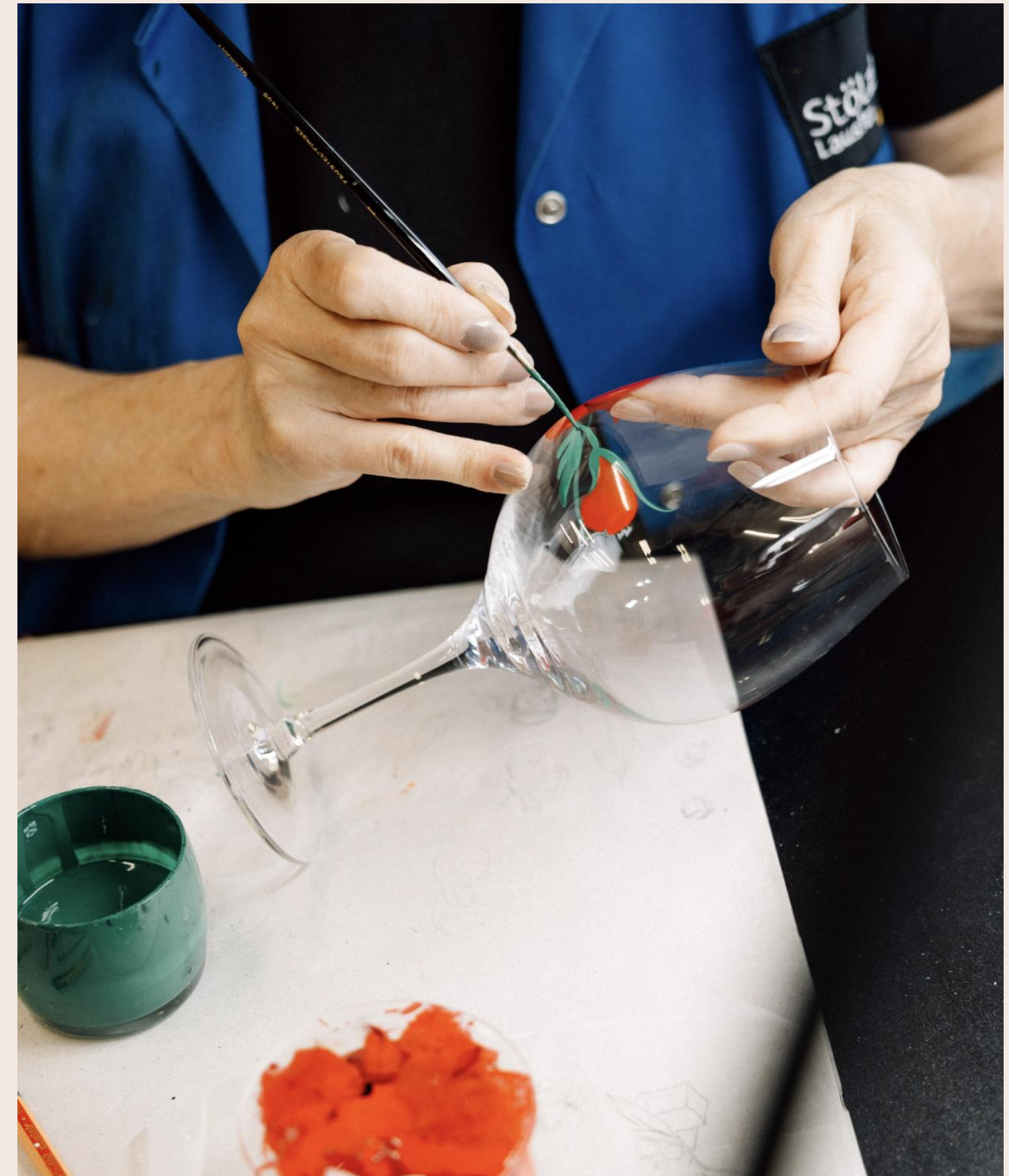

HAND AND MACHINE DECORATION

At Stölzle Lausitz, decoration combines traditional craftsmanship with modern technology, transforming every glass into a unique design piece. Each design can be individually customized, ranging from artistically hand painted details to precise machine applied decorations that perfectly express brand identity and creative individuality.

With decades of experience in glass production and advanced technology, Stölzle offers a broad range of decoration options. Hand painted details, carried out by skilled artisans, are especially valued for exclusive collections and fired at high temperatures to ensure durability and brilliance. Machine decorations, on the other hand, guarantee precision, efficiency and consistent quality suitable for large scale production.



KEY TECHNIQUES:

- Screen Printing: Fully automated printing process with a maximum of 3 colors. Ensures high temperature resistance and long-lasting adhesion
- Hand Painting: Individually hand painted artwork - every piece is unique and especially valued for limited editions and exclusive partnerships
- Pad Printing: Designed for a maximum of 2 colors. Ideal for curved or uneven glass surfaces and precise decorations
- Gold / Silver / Platinum: Metallic decorations, available in single or multicolored finishes
- Decals: Motifs or logos are applied to the glass and fired in the kiln, resulting in a durable glossy finish
- Glass Coloring & Coating: Extensive coated glasses (color applied after production) as well as fully colored glasses (color pigments added directly into the glass melt). Available from transparent tones to fully opaque coatings
- Laser Engraving: Precise engraving of logos or lettering, applied exclusively on the base plates of the glass
- Cutting & Engraving: Decorative, precise machine cuts using diamond technology for fine patterns and high quality details
