CARE INSTRUCTIONS

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# CARE INSTRUCTIONS FOR CRYSTAL GLASS

- Dishwasher safe up to 55°C using mild detergent
- Glass corrosion (haze) may occur after approx. 1,000 rinse cycles if guidelines are not followed
- Avoid contact between glasses and other items to prevent damage
- Ensure glasses are positioned for proper drainage
- Check water hardness to avoid calcification and staining
- Open the dishwasher shortly after the rinsing process to release steam
- Avoid high temperature fluctuations

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## CLEANING BY HAND

- We recommend cleaning glasses by hand using warm water and a soft cloth
- A small amount of mild washing-up liquid can be used if necessary
- Rinse thoroughly with warm, clear water to remove any detergent residue that may affect taste or aroma

## DRYING

- Dry immediately after washing using a soft, lint-free cloth
- Handle with care, especially on thin walls and stems, to avoid pressure damage
- Hold the glass by the bowl when drying

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## TEMPERATURE

- Always rinse with warm water
- Avoid strong temperature fluctuations to prevent breakage

## STORAGE

- Always store glasses on their base, not on the rim
  - Do not stack or nest glasses
  - Ensure glasses are not in contact with each other
