#### 1 Purpose

The purpose of the LPP By-Laws is to ensure that we maintain in an ongoing and orderly manner, the goals stated in the Objectives of the Corporation.

## 2 The Corporation

The Corporation and all of its business and other activities shall be operated and conducted in the promotion of its non-profit objectives and purposes as specified above. In the conduct of its affairs, the officers shall at all times be mindful of these non-profit objectives and purposes.

To further these objectives the officers shall:

- a Provide for administration, accounting/bookkeeping, legal and other professional services as may be deemed appropriate from time to time by the Corporation or its Directors.
- b Maintain a reasonable contingency fund.
- c Pay the operating expenses of the Corporation
- d Assess appropriate fees to further and maintain the goals of the Corporation
- e Maintain and finance a Website to provide financial information, minutes of annual
- meeting, and any other information deemed appropriate.
- f Enforce and ensure compliance with the By-laws.

#### 3 Membership

- a All property owners in the above-mentioned Plans are automatically members of the Corporation.
- b Each household shall be entitled to one (1) vote at all meetings of members.
- c Members shall continue as members for as long as they continue to hold title to their property. When a person ceases to hold such title, the membership shall automatically pass to the transferee of such property.

# 4 Board of Directors/Officers

- a The Board of Directors i.e. Officers shall manage all the day to day operations of the Park and conduct its affairs and activities.
- b The Board of Directors shall be elected at an annual membership meeting of the Park.
- c Authorized number of directors shall be at least three (3) unless and until changed by amendment of the LPP By-laws. There shall be a President, a Secretary, and Treasurer. Officers shall serve for a three (3) year term after being elected and may be reelected.
- d Officers must be members, i.e. property owners in the Corporation.
- e The officers shall receive no compensation for their services.
- f The officers shall set an annual budget and suggest appropriate assessments.
- g The officers shall carry out the day to day business of the Corporation.

### **5 Election of Directors/Officers**

- a If the number of names placed in nomination is equal to or less than the number of positions available no vote is necessary.
- b If the number of names placed in nomination is greater than the number of positions available a vote may be either by show of hands or secret ballot.
- c When vacancies occur on the Board of Directors causing the number to fall to less
- than three (3), the remaining two directors may appoint someone to serve the remaining term of the vacancy.
