The History of Scott Church
Maysville, Kentucky

The church was organized in 1864 by the Rev. Henson Tolbert. In 1869 Rev. Adam Nunn was appointed Active Pastor by the Bishop Levi Scott.

The church was named Scott Chapel after Bishop Scott. The worship services were held in a building on what was then known as Spaulding Hill.

No records of the early church officers were available or the records were lost.

The Rev. John Moreland Sr. was appointed to this charge in 1883 - 1885, It was under his leadership that the land for a new church was purchased, and work started.

The Rev. Alex McDade continue this work from 1885-1888.
The church was finished under the Pastorage of Rev. John Moreland Jr. Son of Rev. John Moreland Sr. who started the church.

The church was started in 1884 in the new building and was dedicated in 1890 by the Rev. John Moreland Jr.
