

A brief History Of SCotts United Methodist Church

Scotts m. e. Church located on east 4th. street was organized in 1864.

The present site was purchased in 1881.

Members of the Church paid for the seats and the windows. the seats were numbered. The chandeliers hanging in the center of the church are over 100 years old.

The church started in 1884 and was dedicated in 1890.

The parsonage was build in 1895. records of early activities of the church are not available.

Recent things that have happened are.

1967 The Scottaires were formed under the direction of Rev. L.H. Fields

77-79 Rev. Pauline Carr, was instrumental in our first Van purchase.

79 - 1982, Rev. Matthew Stevens led us to purchase our central air and heating. and also started our Church in the park, the 3rd. Sun. in August.

1985 Rev. Michael Gant helped the young adults to remodel the nursery.

Rev. Barbara Franks helped to get our Memorial hymnal fund started.

1993 Rev. George Russell helped us realize our Elevator and to have it Consecrated with Plaques of our deceased.

1994 Pastor Benjamin Ward helped us to decide on our new bus. and started our revitalization program.

1995 Rev. Samuel Rowe continuing our revitalization program. He has brought in a great number of new members which have been Baptised. and quite a few have rededicated thier lives.

1997 So on this 23rd. day of Febuary the Church has gained in every way.
