# 1. SERIES HOOK (At-a-Glance)

*Bizzy the Chicken* is a character-forward picture book series that helps young children build real-life social-emotional skills through humor, warmth, and repeatable strategies—without shame, scolding, or didactic instruction.

At the center is Bizzy, an energetic, well-meaning hen who wants to do everything at once, and Patience, her calm, older friend who models how slowing down, pausing, and choosing can make life feel more manageable.

This is SEL told through story, not lessons—designed to be as enjoyable for storytime as it is useful for classrooms.

### 2. BOOK 1 OVERVIEW

### Bizzy the Chicken

Word Count: ~900 words

Age Range: 4-8

Core Skill: Focus & pacing

**Big Idea:** I can slow down and do one thing at a time.

### **Summary:**

Bizzy wakes up ready to tackle a very busy day on the farm—lay eggs, fix her nest, help the chicks, plan a picnic, and more. But as she tries to do everything at once, her feathers fluff, her heart races, and her day turns into a feathery mess. With gentle support from her friend Patience, Bizzy learns to pause, slow down, and finish one thing at a time—discovering that calm helps her feel capable, not less busy.

The story uses repetition, visual pacing, and character contrast to model focus in a way young children can immediately understand and practice.

### 3. THE CHARACTERS

### **Bizzy**

An energetic, curious hen with a big heart and even bigger enthusiasm. Bizzy is capable and eager—but easily overwhelmed when she rushes ahead. She represents the child who wants to do everything *now*.

#### **Patience**

A calm, older hen who serves as Bizzy's emotional anchor. Patience is not a teacher or authority figure; she models steadiness, kindness, and quiet confidence. Her role is to show—not tell—that slowing down is a skill anyone can practice.

Together, they embody action and reflection—two forces every child is learning to balance.

## 4. SERIES VISION & GROWTH

The Bizzy & Patience series is intentionally sequenced to grow with children's developmental needs:

- Book 1: Focus & pacing slowing down
- Book 2: Responsibility finishing tasks and cleaning up
- Book 3: Self-regulation breathing and choosing behavior
- Book 4: Digital citizenship kindness and care in shared digital spaces
- Book 5: Civic engagement caring for shared community spaces

Each book builds on the last, reinforcing the idea that skills are practiced over time—not mastered overnight.

### 5. TONE & APPROACH

- · Humor-forward and character-led
- Emotionally safe (no shame, no correction)
- · Story-first, skill-second
- · Accessible for both home and classroom read-alouds

Visual storytelling plays a central role: busy pages mirror overwhelm, while open space reflects calm and regulation.

The series will appeal to readers of humorous, heart-forward picture books such as: - *The Couch Potato* (Jory John) - *The Smart Cookie* (Jory John) - *I Don't Want to Be a Frog* (Dev Petty) - *Bad Dog* (Mike Boldt)

*Bizzy the Chicken* differentiates itself by pairing a standout character with a repeatable, child-accessible strategy that supports executive function and SEL.
