## What We Do

- We have served nearly **50,000** shoppers.
- On average, we serve around **500** households per week, many of whom are multigenerational.
- **85%** of those served are Latinx families in Sandy Springs.
- We spend approximately **\$30,000** per month for staples, fresh produce, and protein.

## Why We Are Different

### → We Are More Than a Food Pantry

We have created a sense of community through numerous events, including, but not limited to:

- Back-to-school backpack drive for 1,223 school children
- Special opportunities for shoppers to sell their own products and services
- 1,716 children sponsored through Christmas and Hanukkah events
- 650 children shopping at Santa's market for their parents and caretakers
- Monthly community events

### → We Are Volunteer Driven

We have had over **4,500** community volunteers who have experienced the joy of serving in their own back yards. We also have had multiple corporations and civic groups that have supported us through Give Back programs with on-site help.

- two social media blasts per year (1,500 people reached per blast).

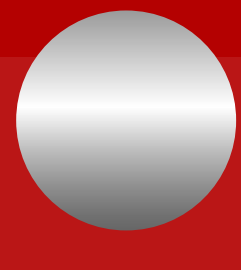


**GOLD**

- one social media blast per year (1,500 people reached).

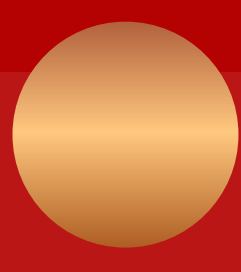


**SILVER**
