General John Sevier was a soldier, frontiersman and politician, and one of the founding fathers of Tennessee. He played a leading role, both militarily and politically, in Tennessee's pre-statehood period. He served as a Colonel of militia and his action significantly contributed to the victory at the Battle of Kings Mountain in 1780. He later commanded frontier militia forces in numerous actions against the Cherokee in the 1780s to 1790s. John Sevier was elected Tennessee's first governor in 1796.

The John Sevier Chapter of the TNSSAR was organized on 16 OCT 1925 in Chattanooga.
