

SALMON CHALLENGE

GENERAL RULES

ELIGIBILITY & PARTICIPATION

Participants must be 18 years of age or older. All participants must download the eTournament Fishing App. An active app subscription is required. ET FISHING reserves the right to disqualify and remove participants from the event at any time.

WAIVER OF LIABILITY

By registering for any ET FISHING challenge event, the participant assumes all liability.

LEGAL FISHING LOCATIONS

Open to all public waters that permit angling in the US and CANADA.

EVENT FORMAT

Participants may submit up to 10 King Salmon per day. Participants may fish any time, 24/7 for the entire month of September. The participants largest, single King Salmon, will be used to calculate standings and results.

LEGAL FISHING TIMES

Anglers may fish at any time during the event. Submissions must be time-stamped prior to the specific end times posted per event when determining weekly and overall winners.

8 HOUR WAITING PERIOR

Any participant registering in a challenge event after it has started may not submit their first fish until 8 hours after registration. Any submission time-stamped prior, will be rejected and will not count.

SPORTSMANSHIP

In the spirit of fair and honest competition, the highest level of sportsmanship is required at all times. No party fishing allowed. Any participant caught cheating will be disqualified. All decisions made by ET FISHING staff are final.

MEASUREMENT PHOTO

A manufactured measurement board must be used in all measurement photos. The measurement photo must show the mouth/nose of the fish clearly touching the bump end of the measurement board and the tail of the fish, pinched or not, clearly visible so an accurate length measurement can be determined. It is the sole responsibility of the participant to provide clear measurement photos.

TROPHY PHOTO

The trophy photo must show the participant that caught the fish. A "selfie photo" is great, just make sure that at a minimum, part of the angler's face and part of the fish is in the photo. Trophy photos may be used for promotional and marketing purposes.

CHECK-IN TO THE EVENT

You may be fishing multiple events in the app at any time. Make sure that you checked in to the correct event. Remember to check in to your event when you are in an area with a good cellular connection.

FORMAT

Participants may enter up to 10 submissions per day. The participant's "current largest single Salmon" will be used to determine weekly and overall results. A Measurement Photo and Trophy Photo are required.
