

Paige Braddock

I am an award-winning artist, writer, and the Chief Creative Officer at Charles M. Schulz Creative Associates. I won an Emmy Award for my work on the Apple documentary, "Who Are You, Charlie Brown?" which won for outstanding nonfiction program. In 2022, I delivered the dedication of the commemorative centennial Schulz stamp at the issuance ceremony. I designed the Snoopy U.S. postage stamp issued in 2001.

I have also illustrated several Peanuts children's books. My other graphic novels for children include the series, Stinky Cecil with Andrews McMeel and Peanut, Butter, & Crackers with Penguin Kids and Nosy Crow. The first book in the latter series, Puppy Problems, won a Beverly Cleary Children's Choice Award in 2023.

My Eisner-nominated comic strip, Jane's World, was the first gay-themed comic to receive online distribution by a national media syndicate in the U.S. I concluded Jane's World after completing its 20th year in 2018.

I have 35+ years in illustration and graphic design and 10 years as a producer in animation. I have an Honorary Doctorate in Fine Arts from Montserrat College of Art. I am represented by Dara Hyde of Hill Nadell Literary Agency.
