

Rolling the Sturmpack with the Mantel is easy to do and it's a great way to transport your gear to the bunker. You'll need:

1. Mantel OR Blanket
2. Mess Tin
3. 5 leather great coat straps
4. 1-2 Bread Bag Straps (If you're bigger in the chest, you'll need 2, I'm a 40 Chest and need 2)
5. 1 Zelt

You start by laying out your zelt square. Then you place your mantel or blanket over the zelt. If a Mantel is used, you unbutton the waist strap, shoulder straps, and unhook the skirt closure at the bottom rear. Then you square up the bottom of the skirt to give a nice edge then fold in the sides of the coat to give a squared look. Turn down the collar until you see the arm holes. Next, you roll from that point all the way to the bottom of the zelt, make it as tight as you can get! Next, place the coat roll along the edge of the zelt and fold in the two sides of the zelt, (If using a blanket, fold in all 4 edges with the zelt edge showing up. Blanket should be in the edges of the zelt.) Now roll the zelt up with the coat inside. Keeping it tight. Once the pack is all rolled, take one strap and connect it in the center of the roll. Then take the mess tin and put a strap on either side on the handle using the button strap part. Then place the mess tin in the center of the roll and fold down both ends and strap them to the zelt roll. Then add two straps linked together to the bottom two rolls. Take bread bag strap and feed it behind the top center strap and connect hooks to the bottom double strap buckle.
