### General Safety

If you become ill or are injured while on site, immediately notify your POC or escort.

You are required to wear a Personal Nuclear Accident Dosimeter while inside the Limited Area.

You may be provided safety glasses, hard hats, hearing protection, hand protection, safety shoes and/or training when needed to enter certain areas.

### Personnel Accountability & Alarms

Should you hear a public address announcement requiring personnel accountability, promptly report to your POC or escort. Initial accountability reports must be made within 15 minutes.



# VISITOR SECURITY INFORMATION

**Welcome to the Paducah Gaseous Diffusion Plant (PGDP)!  
As a visitor to the PGDP site, there are security rules that you  
must be aware of and must follow.**

## SITE ACCESS REQUIREMENTS

### Security Badges

- Security badges must be displayed at all times while on the PGDP property.
- Badges must be worn above the waist, below the neck, with the front of the badge facing forward and on the outer most clothing.
- Return badges to the Badge Office, a badge drop box, or to your Point of Contact (POC) when your visit/work is completed.

### Hobbs Road Access Point

Only the drivers of vehicles are required to validate their badge at the Hobbs Road Access Point. Drivers must ensure all passengers:

- Require entry for official business;
- Have a current Site recognized badge; and
- Do not have any prohibited articles.

### Searches

Personnel, vehicles, and personal property are subject to inspection at any time while on DOE property.

### Escorting

- You will be escorted by an appropriately cleared and trained individual when entering areas that require a security clearance and/or radiological training.
- Follow instructions of your escort at all times.

## PROHIBITED AND CONTROLLED ARTICLES

### Prohibited Articles

The following items are prohibited on the PGDP property:

- Explosives;
- Dangerous weapons (e.g., handguns, rifles, pocket knives with blades over 2.5 inches, pepper spray, mace, stun guns);
  - Law Enforcement officials not performing official duties and those who hold concealed weapons permits from any state, are NOT allowed to bring weapons on DOE property, including inside privately-owned vehicles.
- Instruments or material likely to produce substantial injury to persons or damage to persons or property;
- Controlled substances (e.g., illegal drugs or paraphernalia);
- Any other items prohibited by law.

Other items not permitted on the PGDP site:

- Pets (dogs and other animals)
- Law enforcement personnel on official business are authorized to introduce prohibited/controlled articles that are assigned/carried as part of their required equipment for performing their duties. If the introduction of a prohibited article is necessary for any other reason, the requestor must submit the request through their respective Facility Security Officer (FSO), who will submit it for ODFSA consideration.
- The use of alcoholic beverages on the Site is unauthorized without formal approval by DOE.

### Controlled Articles in the Limited Area (LA)

Vendors, visitors, or subcontractors who require company-owned devices inside the LA are authorized once the item is approved by Cyber Security and it is only used for official business. Vendor owned devices are also authorized but must be approved by Cyber Security and the Vendor must be under proper escort while in the LA. The Escort must ensure the controlled article usage is bound to the intended use and for official business only.

Personally-owned controlled articles equipped with the ability to take photos or record video are not permitted within the LA. This includes vehicles with video recording devices used for insurance purposes (back up cameras are excluded).
