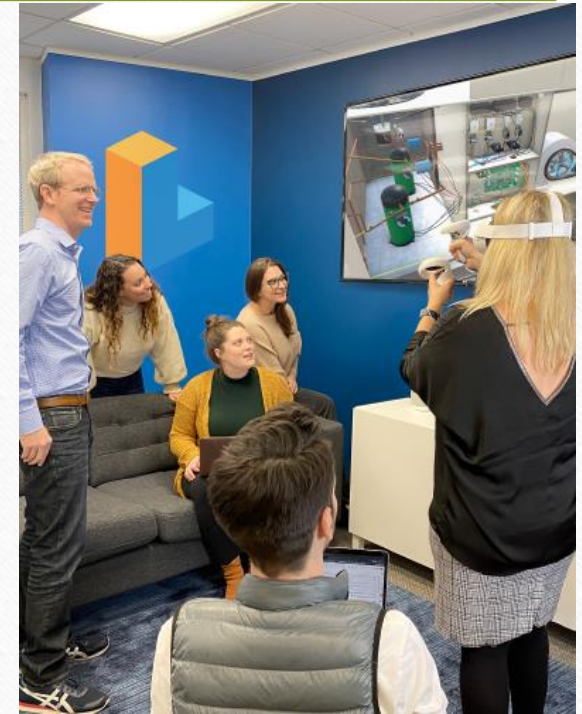

# Scholarships

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- The Foundation distributed \$15,000 in scholarships to graduation seniors in June 2023.
- There are four scholarship funds that include the American Legion Post #36, the Ladies Auxiliary Scholarship, the Gasperine Family Scholarship and the JS Foundation Scholarship.

# AP Exams

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- The Ed Foundation will pay most of the cost of the AP Exams for students when they take them.
- The student is asked to pay \$15 registration fee and the rest of the fee is paid for by the Foundation.
- The Foundation will also pay for NOCTI exams or other certification exams the students may take such as A+ for computer technologies.
