All runs dispatched in Twp were responded to this month with none missed/unavailable.  
No issues to report.

**Part time fill rate:** 117 filled/139 total shifts = 84% 3 days - no personnel on station during the daytime  
Based on: 3 persons/day 4 evenings - no personnel on station during the evening  
2 persons/eve

**On-Call fill rate:** 97 filled/112 total shifts = 87%  
Based on: 4 total slots/day 7 days a week  
2 firefighter slots and 2 EMS slots  
Unfilled days increased from 2 in January to 3 in February. Unfilled nights increased from 0 in January to 4 in February. Part time fill unchanged from 84% in January to 84% in February. On call fill decreased from 93% in January to 87% in February.
