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II. Public Heath – Dr. Colquitt

- A. Encourage everyone to get their flu vaccine
- B. New drug for flu (Xofluza) very expensive, but only one pill \$150. Has been shown to be as effective as, or more effective than Tamiflu. Maybe due to the ease of one pill vs the five days of two pills and how often they are not taken all five days. New England journal article
- C. Polio like cases we have had several in Tarrant county

III. Emergency Management Department -Lourdes M Rodrigues -Lugo

- A. Conducted a three day exercise for a MCI event with the RAC, a few hospitals, and MedStar.
- B. Planning meeting for Ebola \ highly infectious disease table top exercises for the city of Fort Worth.
 - i. Confirmed Can be transported UT Galveston
 - 1. Quarantine and transport MedStar was assigned by the state
 - 2. Could go by air or ground State chose MedStar and CareFlite to transport from FW to Galveston
 - 3. Every Hospital should have it in there Emergency plans
 - a. 6 hour turn around for Ebola testing
 - b. Isolate in a negative pressure room
 - c. Special staff training
 - d. Sample it should be in a protocol but what kind of tube
 - i.Have the currier taken to Dallas county (not Tarrant county)
 - ii. Pediatrics Cooks

IV. FRAB - Chief Spears updated Dr. Floyd by phone since he could not make today's meeting

- A. FRAB has not met since the previous meeting
- B. Image Trend pilot starts on Nov 4 in Fort Worth Chief Cearley
- C. Request for funds review from September meeting- Chief Cearley
 - i. Received a grant for equipment to purchase Zoll monitors
 - ii. One of the requirements for the grant is to have a 10% match which equals \$56,818.00
 - iii. Question: When are the funds needed? Preference is December 1st so the units can be ordered and built, or as soon as possible.
 - iv. Check would need to be made out to the City
