NOTICE OF THE ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING OF THE SEAGULL CONDOMINIUM ASSOCIATION, INC.

Under the provisions of Florida Statutes, Chapters 718 & 721, the **Annual Membership Meeting of the Seagull Condominium Association, Inc. will be held directly following a noon luncheon on Saturday, January 8, 2022, at the Veteran's Memorial located at 400 S. Sykes Creek Pkwy in Merritt Island, FL. The meeting will follow a complimentary luncheon which will be served at 12:00 noon. <u>Reservations are required</u>. Please make your reservation <u>by January 1, 2022</u>. Reservations may be made by calling 321-783-4441. Due to limited seating, reservations will be limited to the first 100 people. If you must cancel, please call as soon as possible to allow others to attend.**

Notice is hereby given that there will be <u>no election of directors</u> needed for Seagull Condominium Association, Inc. for 2022. Since only two candidates served a "Notice of Intent to Run" to the Association by the prescribed date, the two vacant seats will be filled by those candidates – Jack Robbins (current president) and Jeffrey Mayers (current secretary).

IF YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO ATTEND THE ANNUAL MEETING AS DESCRIBED ABOVE, PLEASE BE SURE TO COMPLETE AND RETURN THE ENCLOSED VOTING CERTIFICATE. ALL ELIGIBLE VOTERS MUST ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURES IN ORDER THAT THEIR VOTE IS COUNTED:

- 1. Complete the "Voting Certificate" indicating your appointment for Limited Proxy and your vote for authorizing the Board of Directors to determine the disposition of Operating Surplus for 2021 (if any) and reallocation of funds within the Replacement Reserve Fund. Be sure to read the certificate carefully and mark it appropriately. Make sure that all owners sign and date the certificate where indicated and list each week-unit owned by you.
- 2. Return the completed "Voting Certificate" to the Association by the time of the annual meeting. There is no need for any special envelopes to return this proxy to the Association.
- 3. The completed certificate may be mailed to the association or hand delivered to the office at the address indicated below. They <u>must be received by the association by 8:00 am on January 8, 2022</u>, in order to be counted.

Everyone,

We certainly hope that this message finds all of our owners safe and secure at this time. Here, at Seagull, things are moving forward in spite of still being short-staffed. We have gone back to making the beds in the bedrooms as our check-out numbers have declined because we have many long-term owners "in house". This means more stay-over cleans on Thursdays and Fridays and less check-outs on Saturdays, a more workable situation.

We are having an in-person Annual Meeting and luncheon on Saturday, January 8, 2022, from 12:00noon – 1:30pm at the Veteran's Memorial behind the Merritt Island Mall. Please check page 1 of the newsletter for more detailed instructions on how to RSVP.

We have completed the walk-in shower modification and only have 5 reclining sofas left to replace. Unfortunately, because of Covid, everything is back-ordered. We are also waiting on the last shipment of mattresses (5), to complete this project as well. I have contracted a company to rebuild the pool deck, as it is collapsing on the side by the public walkway, but they are way behind and won't begin construction until December. The pool will remain open but the upper deck will be closed during this time.

I have answered many emails and phone calls about the timing of the elevator remodification but at this time there isn't a scheduled date. As there are only a few companies that are licensed by the state to perform the modifications, we are at their mercy. I will give you as much notice as I can when a date is selected, but this will be a hardship that we will all have to deal with at that time. FYI, in order to fund the elevator modernization without an assessment, one of the things we had to cut was the weekly picnic, which cost about \$5,000 per year. Hopefully we will resume the picnic again in 2023.

We now have a new Direct TV system up and running with many more channels and great picture on every station. We installed the system during maintenance week and after a few weeks, the "bugs" have been worked out. They gave us NFL Ticket for the first year at no cost so check the guide when you arrive to see our expanded TV services.

The staff has been working very hard during Covid to ensure that our owners and guests are very well accommodated in every way possible. You have no idea how hard it has been to try and keep the resort running and operating as smoothly as possible. Many other resorts are closing or limiting their occupancy during these difficult times. A hearty Thank You! to our dedicated staff and Board of Directors is definitely warranted.
