BURGLARY PREVENTION

- Make sure that all windows and doors are secure
- 2. If you have an alarm system, use it
- 3. Utilize lights inside and outside your home. Use timers and motion sensors
- 4. Make sure your neighbors know when you will be gone
- Have neighbors or friends collect your mail and newspapers while you're away
- 6. Keep bushes trimmed down to prevent hiding places and trees trimmed up for good visibility
- 7. Install deadbolt locks with 3/4 inch throw
- 8. Install strong doorframes
- 9. Be a good neighbor; watch out for one another
- 10. Record the license and description of any suspicious vehicle or persons
- 11. Don't leave garage doors open
- 12. Keep packages out of view from open windows
- 13. Record all serial numbers on our Home Inventory record book or Excel program. Also participate in the "Operation Identification" Program.
