

BURGLARY PREVENTION

1. Make sure that all windows and doors are secure
2. If you have an alarm system, use it
3. Utilize lights inside and outside your home. Use timers and motion sensors
4. Make sure your neighbors know when you will be gone
5. Have neighbors or friends collect your mail and newspapers while you're away
6. Keep bushes trimmed down to prevent hiding places and trees trimmed up for good visibility
7. Install deadbolt locks with 3/4 inch throw
8. Install strong doorframes
9. Be a good neighbor; watch out for one another
10. Record the license and description of any suspicious vehicle or persons
11. Don't leave garage doors open
12. Keep packages out of view from open windows
13. Record all serial numbers on our Home Inventory record book or Excel program. Also participate in the "Operation Identification" Program.

STEALINGS

1. Always lock your car with the windows up
2. Don't leave anything of value inside your vehicle in plain sight: cell phones, GPS, brief-cases, packages, etc.
3. Lock items in the trunk of your car
4. Park your car in a well-lighted area
5. Don't leave your garage door opener visible in your car
6. Make sure the license plates on your car are well secured. Remove old tabs before replacing them with new ones. Use protective covers
7. Don't leave your purse unattended in a shopping cart
8. Don't leave change or cash in console.
9. Don't leave your car unlocked

AUTO THEFT PREVENTION

1. Don't leave your car unlocked
2. Don't leave keys in your car
3. Utilize theft prevention devices. (The Club, alarms, kill switches, etc.)
