

The Char-baagh – A microcosm of the Universe


- At the centre of a square garden is the source of energy (water) and it is from this energy that the thought/soul (garden) is nourished

ONLY ONE ARM OF THE CHAHAR-BAGH IS A WATER CHANNEL.








