- The Receptions Director's report was tabled updating council on the winterfest ideas and schedule.


### **New and Other Business**

2. The Master card report was tabled for councils review. With fuel prices continually rising and fuel efficiency being first and foremost. The Town will start looking at if it's economically feasible to purchase a new vehicle at this time. The town manager will speak to neighboring towns that have made a similar purchase recently.
3. The Fuel report was tabled and all numbers are correct. New lighting and a new locking system seems to be working.
4. Discussion was held around the street light out at the intersection town sign area. Access has been limited with upgrades to the Viking Trail. Due to there being steel pole workers can't climb to repair. Council will continue to work with NL Power to have this rectified. Upgrades will have to take place the summer.


Resolution 023-009                      Councilor Ems/ Toope 4 For, 0 Opposed, Carried
