Enhancements at Reading Aviation FBO

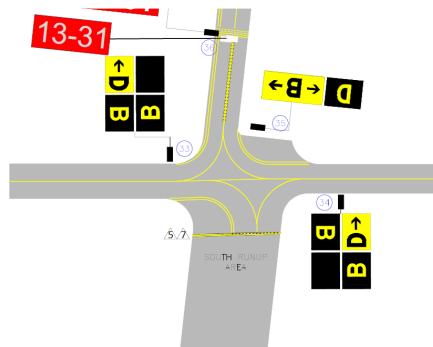
Exciting updates are underway at the Reading Aviation FBO at Reading Regional Airport. The interior is being refreshed with thoughtful upgrades, including new accent pieces in the snooze room and coffee bar, creating a more comfortable and inviting space for pilots and guests.

Delta Run-up Area Update

A recent update has been made to the airport layout to improve access and operations on the field. The former Taxiway D run-up area has been reconfigured to create a new entrance to the Netjets facility and apron area. As a result, aircraft crews will notice adjusted taxiway centerlines and the addition of a non-movement area boundary near the Taxiway D and

Taxiway B intersection. These changes are intended to support increased aircraft staging and parking for Netjets, and an updated FAA Airport Diagram reflecting these modifications will be published this month.
