# Sunday School - Write a Commercial

(As an example, do they ever promise that you'll be happy or beautiful or that you'll never be lonely if you use a cetain product?) How is the music in commercials important?

Read 2 Chronicles 5:2-14. King David had the Levites write songs and lead the people in praising God. One song they wrote was something like a TV commercial for God (2 Chronicles 5:13)!

Write a family commercial for God. Think what to say about him that would make other people want to know and worship God too. Use a tune you know to go with your commercial for God. Than ask yourself whether God can keep the promises he makes!
