On October 3<sup>rd</sup>, 1863, President Abraham Lincoln issued a proclamation establishing a day of thanksgiving for the nation. The nation was in the midst of the Civil War. It was a time of great uncertainty. It had only been a few months since the Battle of Gettysburg which marked the deadliest battle in the war. Thousands had perished since the war began and despite some critical victories during the year, the outcome of the war was far from certain. In this perilous moment, Lincoln proclaimed there would be a national day of thanksgiving.

Many families were mourning losses. Many families were separated because of the draft that had gone into effect earlier that year. Many families were facing uncertain economic futures. I'm sure there were many who questioned the wisdom of calling for a day to give thanks. Lincoln did not ignore the suffering that people were facing, he recognized that even in the midst of cruel hardship, there were many reasons to give thanks.

We once again find ourselves in trying times. Our families have been disrupted. Ordinary expectations have been put on hold or canceled all together. Employment, economic security, good health... all these things have been subject to greater and greater levels of uncertainty. The church has not been immune from uncertainty. We went for two months without any worshippers in our sanctuary. For the last several months our worship has been different and distanced. Each one of us could probably spend hours reciting the ways this year has been unlike any other. We need some thanksgiving time.

We don't need the huge family gatherings. We don't need the football. We don't need the feasts. We don't need the bargain deals. What we need is to draw near to the heart of God, confessing the disruption to our lives and reveling in the blessings we have received. Whatever your Thanksgiving looks like this year, I pray that you take some intentional time to give thanks to God.
