The promise of the church is this: none of us alone are Christ (that's blasphemy,) but all of us together are Christ to the world (that's ecclesiology)." -Shane Claiborne & Chris Haw, Jesus for President.

I first read those words nearly a decade ago and they were first published in the midst of a tumultuous presidential campaign between John McCain and Barak Obama. In many ways it seems like so long ago. So much life has happened in the last decade. Earthquakes, floods, hurricanes, fires, and countless other disasters have changed the landscape of the world. Political and social movements like the Arab Spring have brought sweeping changes not only in far-off parts of the world, but often right here at home. The economy has undergone great booms and great recessions, there have been bull and bear markets, there has been record employment and record unemployment. Terrorism and radical violence continues to be a present danger as we have witnessed attacks in Boston, Paris, London, Barcelona, Orlando, Auckland, Sri Lanka, and many other places in the world. School shootings have claimed the lives of nearly 200 students in the United States in the last 10 years. So much life has happened, and none of that includes what 2020 has thrown at us with a global health crisis challenging every aspect of public life, civil and social unrest, and another tumultuous presidential campaign.

I do not pretend to know what the next ten years will hold for our world or even our community. Ten years from now, in October 2030, I may very well be looking back on these days as the calm before the storm... but it is equally likely that I will look back and be awed by how resilient and faithful we have been through these days of trial.

What I can say, with assurance today, is that whoever is elected President on November 3rd will not create the world we wish to see. The most ambitious social safety net still leaves too many hurting, too many homeless, too many hungry. The boldest plan for safety and security still leaves too many frightened and too many in harm's way. The challenges we face cannot be solved by governments, corporations, or institutions... but they can be solved by radical faith. When we begin to embody the life of Jesus Christ, we become the change-agents who create a better world.

This year, as we draw near to the end of another election season, my prayer isn't that you agree with me on who would serve us best in Washington or in Albany. My prayer is that you elect to be the body of Christ for the world... because as Claiborne and Haw remind us "You are the only Jesus some people will ever see."
