hat is a church? This is a question that I

think we need to ask ourselves more often. Anyone who has sung Richard Avery and Donald Marsh's hymn "*We Are the Church*" may have a head start on the idea that the church is not the building that we meet in, the church is the body of people who have come together in common community with one another.

In the New Testament the church was called the ekklesia and referred specifically to a group of people called together for a meeting. It wasn't until the fourth century that the church began to refer to the building space rather than the people. Over the course of many years we have have begun to incorporate both views into our modern understanding of "the church". We talk about church being a place that we go and as a people to whom we belong. Those called into positions of church leadership are continually called to church maintenance and growth, both of the physical space and of the communal body.

How can we announce that our church is not a building but a community for all people that has been called together by the love of God, and how can we live out our faith with one another in ways that are rich and authentic to our relationship with God? As we journey together as a church I pray that we will discover remarkable and faithful ways of answering these questions, and in answering these questions I pray we will discover what it means to be the church.
