FIRST AID

FOR USE WITH AGRICULTURAL AND INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTS

ALLIGARE 90 WEST is a highly concentrated, low-foam, non-ionic spreader activator and defoaming agent. **ALLIGARE 90 WEST** increases the activity and effectiveness of agricultural insecticides, fungicides, and herbicides by breaking down the waxy cuticle on the leaf surface, and improves adhesion between the pesticide and the plant surface.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This Product Cannot Be Used For Aquatic Applications.

For use with insecticides (livestock sprays), fungicides, miticides: Use ½ to ½ pint (4 to 8 fl. Oz.) per 100 gallons of water.

For use with herbicides (terrestrial), defoliants, desiccants: Use ½ to 4 pints (8 to 64 fl. Oz.) per 100 gallons of water.

In difficult wetting situations (such as hard water on mature waxy foliage) the higher rates may be required.

NOTE: The application rates on this label are based on pesticide labels, which recommend the use of a nonionic surfactant. Rates of this product may be increased or decreased. For optimum results, follow pesticide labeling for proper recommendations. Before using **ALLIGARE 90 WEST**, where a nonionic surfactant may not be recommended, the user or applicator advisor must have experience with the combination, or must have conducted a phytotoxicity trial.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool well-ventilated place. Keep in original container tightly closed. Do not reuse empty container. Do not store with food, feed, or other material to be used or consumed by humans or animals. Do not contaminate water supplies. For optimal storage, store between 40° and 90° F.

DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Dispose of contents in container to an approved waste disposal facility in accordance with all federal, state and local regulations. Triple rinse (or equivalent) adding rinse water to application tank. Offer container for recycling or dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other procedures approved by local regulations.
