- 10. An equilateral triangle has three equal angles. Find each angle.

- 1. A window is in the shape of a parallelogram. One angle is 120°. Find the other three angles.
- 2. A kite-shaped sign has one angle of 90° and another of 85°. Find the other two angles.
- 3. A bridge support is shaped like an isosceles triangle. One base angle is 65°. Find the other base angle and the top angle.
- 4. A trapezium-shaped table has angles of 80° and 100° on one side of the parallel lines. Find the angles on the other side.
- 5. A flag is in the shape of a right-angled triangle. If one angle is 35°, find the other non-right angle.
- 6. A rhombus-shaped mirror has one angle of 70°. Find all the other angles.
- 7. A picture frame is in the shape of a square. What are the properties of its diagonals?
- 8. A doorstop is shaped like a scalene triangle. What does this mean about its sides and angles?
- 9. A sports pitch is a rectangle. What are the properties of its opposite angles and sides?
- 10. A triangular road sign is isosceles. If its base angle is 72°, find the third angle.
