Buckeye Regional Delegate Report 10-12-24

RD was not able to attend the virtual Midwest zonal forum meeting. These meetings are usually all day long events, but I was not able to get on until noonish and the meeting had already wrapped up. Contacted Tri-state RD to see if I missed anything vital, and it sounds like not much going on right now. Buckeye is scheduled to host the in person MZF in august of 2025.

I was able to attend the world conference participants webinar 9/21/24, most of which was focused on the world convention, as it had just happened couple weeks prior. WCNA 38 was a financial loss, but WB was not able to give exact numbers yet as they still had to finalize some payments. The Website crashed leading up to WCNA, the plan was to have a financial statement available on this webinar, but they did not want to provide any half measures or cause confusion. ( this is also a reoccurring theme ) The info that they did offer was:

- 6.88 million in cash accounts, not counting money in Iran
- 3.5 is from WCNA
- There will be a WCNA merch tab added to NA.org to sell through left over Merchandise
- NA Survival Kit is available on NA.org for \$20 ( new literature)
- In person registrations at WCNA were the lowest they had been history
- They are asking out loud, repeatedly, for members to make contributions
- They signed up 528 new member contributions, for total of \$28,500

Some questions have arisen about what the World Services provides, some examples are : Protect copyrights, translations, webinars, website and world convention.

I was contacted by World board to help assist a group trying to start a new meeting in Necomerstown, Ohio ( That's a real place) I passed info on to PR Chair






