Congratulations to **Marcia B** CLACNA 14 Treasurer (Interim til Feb ‘27)

New Business/Group Concerns:

P/R Chair (ASC Chair) verified via CLACNA Chair that the Zoom meeting situation has been resolved.

Literature Chair (ASC V/Chair) reported Lit. sales of \$836.38 and requested \$1,114.17 for the current order. We have an inventory balance of \$6843.51 (approx.). We need an add’l pmt to WSC for \$7.00 for miscalculation on last order. The Lit Chair further stated that “I am returning the ASC computer because I’d rather use my own”. The ASC Chair received the computer (see add’l info log).

Activities Chair turned in \$837 as well as \$517 turned in to ASC V/Chair, turning in a M/O for \$320. The event cost Area \$362.07, including \$200 for rent of the facility (Game Night), and requested a refund to a member for \$10.36

RCM stated that he would not be at the Region meeting April 11th nor at the ASC meeting April 19th.

Treasurer requested budget, approved.

Treasurer Asst. addressed GSRs concerning applying for Statutory Agent and paying with her credit card, GSRs okayed it (10 for 1 abst)..

ASC Sec’y requested and was granted the budget.

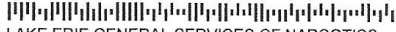

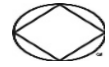
