Recommendations for AREA LEGS Banking

Good afternoon, as some of you might know that a AREA LEGS CALL MEETING was scheduled for September 07,2025 at 2pm at the Thea Bowman center to discuss AREA LEGS/CLACNA14 banking matters. Only three GSR's present for the meeting so, we were unable to handle some important matters at that meeting due to quorum requirements. As you have heard by now the AREA LEGS checking account was compromised and the old account had to be closed and a new account was opened immediately so that no further illegal activity could be transacted on that account, also so the business of AREA LEGS could resume its normal banking activities. Two fraudulent checks were made up with the Area LEGS account numbers and one was transacted successfully for \$933.00 and another was attempted to be cashed for \$900.00 dollars but was stopped by bank personnel that became suspicious when viewing the account activity. The fraud was reported to US Bank and a police report was filed with the Cleveland Police Department. Three members of the ASC service committee met with US Bank personnel to see what's the best way moving forward to better protect the Area LEGS banking account and change our some our banking practices. Here are a couple of the recommendation derived from that meeting.

Do not share accounts with CLACNA14 using the same EIN number.
 Even though there are two separate account numbers there can only be one email address used as the default address. We had some

- issues with monies that were Zelle to Area LEGS that ended up in the CLACNA14 account.
- 2. Get a credit card for AREA LEGS to pay bills that we would normally have to send a check for payment. First reason credit cards are safer to use, and if stolen or compromised the monies are returned much faster to the account than with debit card or check fraud. Secondly, paying the total balance at the time of payment accumulates no interest charge and finally there is no yearly fee for having the card.
- 3. For bills that are paid every month, have them paid directly from the checking account, such as rent to Thea Bowman and Cube Smart. This method is called ACH where monies are directly deposited from one account to another account at a specific date each month.
- 4. Use Zelle to make payment for monthly budgets and others monies needed. We were told minimize check writing at all cost.
- 5. It was suggested that certain alerts be added to the account so that, If unusual activity appears to be happening within the account signers on the account will be immediately notified by email or text message.

At Area LEGS Call meeting all the above suggestions were discussed and reviewed. We followed the Area LEGS call meeting format and here are a few suggestions that derived from the AREA LEGS CALL MEETING.

 It was suggested that when checks are absolutely necessary get a counter check or cashier check from US Bank. The reason stated

because, there is no account information on the check that can be traced back to an account. There is a fee for these checks.

- 2. Zelle monies to all Subcommittee chairpersons that have checking accounts.
- 3. ACH all monthly bills directly from AREA LEGS checking account that can be paid normally by check.
- 4. Discussed the account separation with CLACNA14 Treasure Connus J who was also present for the meeting. CLACNA was in agreement that the two accounts could not remain at the same bank under the same EIN number due to the previous issues with Zelle transactions. We were informed by CLACNA14 Treasurer Connus J that CLACNA14 was closing the account at US Bank and opening a new one at Bank Of America. Finally we talked about the monies that were Zelle to the CLACNA14 checking account being returned and Connus J addressed that situation to the group and was prepared to write a check for the two transactions. Both zelle transactions totaled an amount of \$221.00. Connus J was advised to wait until the ASC monthly meeting due to the new checking account CLACNA14 was opening that week.

The meeting ended with a moment of silence and the Serenity Prayer.

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PETITION TO AREA LEGS ASC FOR REDRESS OF A PERSONAL GRIEVANCE

The Tenth Concept is our fellowship's guarantee of respect for the individual trusted servant. This concept may seem self-evident, but our belief in the principle involved is so strong that we want to say it loudly and clearly. Narcotics Anonymous is a spiritual society, with high ideals for how we treat each other. Our members, however, are only human, and we sometimes mistreat one another. The Tenth Concept is our spiritual society's promise that if one of us is wronged in the service environment, the aggrieved trusted servant may ask that the wrong be made right.

. EIGHTH CONCEPT Our service structure depends on the integrity and effectiveness of our communications. Our fellowship's service structure is founded on the unity of our groups; to maintain that union, we must have regular communications throughout Narcotics Anonymous. Together, our groups have created a service structure to meet their common needs and to help them fulfill their common purpose. The effectiveness of the service structure depends on the continued unity of the NA groups, and on their continued support and direction. These things can only be maintained in an atmosphere of honest, open, and straightforward communication among all parties concerned.

My Grievance is that the Legs ASC'S votes regarding the New Attitudes' Group, undated motion, submitted to ASC, was in direct violation of ASC Guideline 1c., the Twelve Tradition, Tenth and Eighth Concepts, by stating that:

1. The above motion contained false allegations claiming that the allegations were facts, however, the dictionary definition a fact is, " a thing that is known or proven to be true." Since no evidence was ever presented to the ASC that the allegations were proven to be known or proven to be true, the ASC mistreated and disrespected trusted servant, Ali A, who was the ASC Vice Chair, at that time, by voting, on July 20, 2025, as if the allegations were true, and by

voting that trusted servant, Ali A be removed from his trusted servant position based upon unproven allegations, as such a vote violates the Tenth Concept of NA. Trusted servant, Ali A. will not repeat any of the unfounded allegations contained in the motion, because that would be a waste of time.

However, Ali A. hereby categorially denies that any of the unfounded allegations contained in the motion ever happened, as alleged, and no one has proven otherwise.

- 2. On July 20. 2025, the above motion was read, on the ASC floor, voted to Business. Then after less than Ten Minutes of discussion, the GSR's voted that the motion passed. This is the process required by ASC Guideline # 13. However, on August 17, 2025, the GSR's voted that this method of processing all Main Motions. Constituted the satisfaction of the request made in the same motion that, "Ali A's action be formally reviewed by the AREA LEGS Service Committee" when the GSRs' knew that was not the truth. The truth is that the normal process for all main motions does not constitute the review called for in the motion. Therefore, this vote constitutes a violation of the Eighth Concept of NA, which requires that a atmosphere of Honesty in our communication be maintained among all parties concerned.
- 3. The vote, passing the above motion was in violation ASC Guideline 1c., due to the motion being OUT OF ORDER, because it does not have a date on it.
- 4. Both of these votes were made in violation of the Twelve Tradition of NA, because they were based on personalities instead of principles.

Trusted servant, Ali A, is not submitting this grievance with any expectation of being reinstated to any former position, but only with

the expectation, as unrealistic it may be, that the ASC body collectively and individually will exercise our Tenth Step and promptly admit that both the above votes are wrong.

Finally, trusted servant, Ali A. realizes while exercising the Tenth Step, that he is not blameless. Although the allegations made against him are not true, as alleged, he played a negative part that contributed to the allegations being made against him, he will try to do better, as he prays that we all will try to treat each other better.

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
