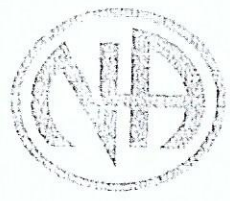

Greg H. reported that he will begin contacting vendors in order to select three vendors to provide pricing for sweatshirts and Tshirts (both long sleeve and short sleeve).

Reginald K reports that he will begin looking into vendors to purchase bucket hats.

Questions and suggestions for this committee:

2. Tracey informed the committee that vendor contracts need to clearly specify what each vendor will be selling. Tracey also discussed establishing a deadline for vendors' bids.
