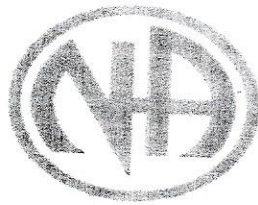

Topics for the Speaker Jam were read and discussed.

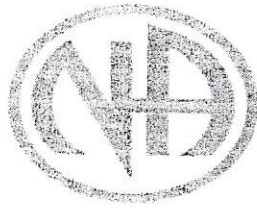
Subcommittee discussed asking speakers if they have working knowledge of the Twelve Steps.

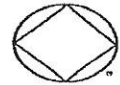

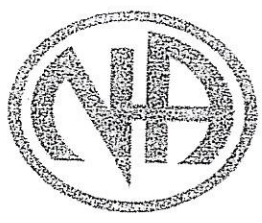

5. Members decided on colors of hats and t-shirts.

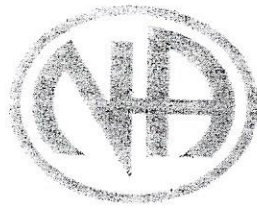
New business:

 - B. 25 green bucket hats; priced \$10.
 - C. 25 blue baseball caps; priced \$10.
 - D. Shipping will cost \$30.
 - E. Total will be \$1,030.00
2. Merchandise committee proposes selling the long-sleeved t-shirts for \$25. Bucket hats and baseball caps sold for \$15. If a patron wants to buy a set it would cost \$35.
3. The breakdown for sizes is: 5 small, 5 medium, 10 large, 15 XL, 10 2x, 5 3x which totals 50 shirts split between colors.
