New Attitudes Motion: Mismanagement of AREA L.E.G.S. Financial Materials and Breach of Trusted Servant Responsibilities

### **Background and Chronology of Events:**

In March 2025, Ali A., then serving as the AREA L.E.G.S. Vice Chair, retrieved mail from the AREA L.E.G.S. P.O. Box. This mail included sensitive financial information, including bank account numbers. Rather than securing these materials, Ali A. left them unaccounted for and unattended on a table at Thea Bowman Center, where AREA meetings are held. This act of negligence posed a risk to the security and integrity of AREA L.E.G.S financial assets.

On March 24, 2025, after being newly elected Vice Chair, Ali A. contacted the bank to inquire about the names of signers on the account and requested the date and time of the next scheduled meeting. He also asked for the account balance. Despite initiating this contact, Ali A. failed to attend the scheduled meeting. The bank manager directed him to contact Gina H. (AREA Treasurer & Statutory Agent) and Konnis J. (CLACNA Treasurer). Notably, Ali A. never followed up with either individual as instructed.

On April 4, 2025, Konnis J., CLACNA Treasurer, was contacted by the bank via email notifying him that the checks associated with the AREA L.E.G.S. account had arrived. In response, Konnis attempted to coordinate with Ali A. to obtain the checks.

On April 8, 2025, Ali A., unaccompanied by another trusted servant, again accessed the P.O. Box, retrieved the checks, and opened them. When Konnis J. requested the checks, Ali A. refused to relinquish them to him or any other member. Craig D. (CLACNA Chair) also attempted to intervene, but Ali A. remained non-compliant.

On April 9, 2025, Gina H. (AREA Treasurer) directly asked Ali A. to turn over the checks. He again refused and stated, "I'm going to give them to Andre" (referring to Andre, AREA Chair).

On May 18, 2025, the checks were discovered opened and unattended on a table at Thea Bowman Center, again compromising the security and confidentiality of AREA L.E.G.S. funds. It is assumed, based on the timeline and prior behavior, that Ali A. had opened and left them there.

On or around May 12, 2025, the existing account was formally closed. A new account was opened by Konnis J., and all funds were successfully transferred to the new account where they remain secure.

### **Conclusion and Motion:**

These events constitute multiple and significant breaches of trust and service protocol. Ali A.'s repeated refusal to cooperate with other trusted servants, failure to follow the bank's directive, and mishandling of sensitive financial materials placed AREA L.E.G.S. and C.L.A.C.N.A. at

risk. His behavior demonstrates a clear disregard for Narcotics Anonymous guidelines, which emphasize that *no one member should conduct business alone on behalf of the fellowship*.

### Motion:

We move that Ali A.'s actions be formally reviewed by the AREA L.E.G.S. Service Committee, and that appropriate accountability measures be pursued in accordance with the 12 Traditions and the group's service guidelines. Furthermore, we recommend that Ali A. be temporarily suspended from access to all financial materials, meetings involving financial decisions, and the AREA L.E.G.S. P.O. Box, pending the outcome of this review.

# GROUP/SUBCOMMITTEE MOTION WITH EXPLANATION:

Motion: We move that AREA L.E.G.S. approve the creation of an Assistant position for the Treasurer for the CLACNA convention.

Explanation: Currently, the Treasurer position is the only CLACNA convention position without a designated Assistant to support the responsibilities associated with the service position. Establishing an Assistant position would align the service structure of CLACNA with that of AREA L.E.G.S. subcommittees, all of which have Vice Chairs or Assistants in place to promote continuity, shared responsibility, and leadership development. This motion is being submitted in the interest of: 1. Continuity of Service: If the Treasurer is unable to fulfill their duties due to unforeseen circumstances, the Assistant Treasurer would be equipped to step in and ensure that CLACNA's financial responsibilities continue without disruption. 2. Accountability and Oversight: An Assistant Treasurer would provide an added layer of accountability, promoting financial transparency and assisting in oversight of budget tracking, documentation, and reporting. 3. Support and Leadership Development: This position would serve as a valuable learning opportunity for future trusted servants, ensuring that knowledge and experience are passed on effectively within the subcommittee. 4. Consistency with AREA Service Structure: Approving this role ensures consistency and equity among CLACNA subcommittees, in keeping with the principles of service outlined in the Twelve Concepts for NA Service—specifically Concept Eleven (see 12 Concepts) Conclusion: For the integrity, efficiency, and spiritual alignment of our service efforts, we respectfully request that AREA L.E.G.S. vote to establish the position of Assistant for the CLACNA Treasurer, to be implemented with appropriate updates to the CLACNA guidelines.

### GROUP/SUBCOMMITTEE MOTION WITH EXPLANATION:

MOTION: To establish an Assistant Secretary Position for the CLACNA Convention Executive Body Submitted by: CLACNA XIV Executive Body Motion: We move that the governing body of AREA L.E.G.S. approve the creation of an Assistant Secretary position within the CLACNA Convention.

Explanation: At this time, the CLACNA Executive Body does not include an Assistant Secretary, unlike other roles across AREA subcommittees that have designated support positions. The addition of an Assistant Secretary would enhance the operational effectiveness of the committee, ensure continuity of documentation, and promote greater accountability and leadership development. This motion is proposed in the interest of: 1. Continuity of Service: In the event the Secretary is unable to fulfill their duties—such as taking minutes, maintaining records, or communicating with members—the Assistant Secretary could step in to ensure these vital functions are maintained without disruption. 2. Accountability and Accuracy: Having a second trusted servant involved in documentation adds a layer of verification and quality control. This strengthens the integrity of meeting records and other communications. 3. Support and Leadership Development: This position would provide a valuable service opportunity for a member to gain experience in executive-level responsibilities, ensuring a smoother leadership transition in the future if the Secretary role becomes vacant. 4. Consistency with AREA Service Structure: This addition aligns CLACNA with the structure of other subcommittees that include assistant or vice roles. It supports the values expressed in the NA Twelve Concepts—particularly Concepts Four, Eight, and Nine—which highlight the importance of effective leadership, delegation, and accountability within our service bodies. Conclusion: For the continued growth, functionality, and spiritual integrity of the CLACNA Executive Body, we respectfully request that AREA L.E.G.S. vote to approve the establishment of an Assistant Secretary position, with responsibilities to be defined and incorporated into CLACNA's operating guidelines.


