The moment many of you have been waiting for is here: The 2020 *Conference Agenda Report (CAR)* has been posted at [www.na.org/conference](http://www.na.org/conference). Versions in Arabic, French, Portuguese, Spanish, and Swedish will be published by 26 December 2019. We are working on PowerPoints and videos to help with CAR workshops. We mailed copies of the CAR to Conference participants, zonal contacts, regional service committees, and zonal forums this week. We will fill all orders for paper copies of the CAR as quickly as we can. Each copy costs \$13.50, which includes shipping and handling, but does not include taxes.

Once again, the CAR includes a survey about literature, service material, and Issue Discussion Topics.
