RD Report to BRSCNA,
August 8, 2020

Today is Day Two of the second part of the World Service Conference. During the first part of the Conference back in April, participants passed an emergency budget and several project plans. We also agreed to meet in this second part of the Conference to discuss and vote on the motions proposed by regions in the 2020 Conference Agenda Report. Yesterdays sessions were very productive. There was also a nice pace, everyone was focused, and I felt that spiritual connection we get when we are together. All of that was missing from the first part of the Conference, so it is encouraging that the second part is so much better.

We started the session with a decision on how we would conduct discussion and decision-making. The process used at each World Service Conference is always evolving and the World Board did a great job of adapting our process to an online platform and this motion was passed with unanimous support.

Next, we approved the minutes from the last WSC in 2018, and then moved on to CAR motions.

The "Mental Health in Recovery" IP was approved with unanimous support. There was support for the motion to create audio formats of our literature in Spanish and the final decision on that motion will be made at the end of the conference. We passed the motion to direct the Board to create a project plan for an informative video about NA for public relations efforts.

We spent a great deal of time on the CAR motion to direct the Board to create a project plan to create a guide for online meetings. That motion passed with consensus support, but there was an amendment that was debated and ultimately failed. The amendment involved the recognition and registration of online groups.

Finally, we approved some minor changes to the Guide to World Services in NA.

During the sessions today and tomorrow, we expect to vote on zonal seating and whether to seat two regions who have applied: Minas and NW Russia. We will also likely continue the suspension of the Fellowship Intellectual Property Trust that began in 2018. The IP about Women in Recovery proposed by Iran will be our last order of business. I will post a final report of motions passed on Slack.

The only other thing on my radar is the upcoming planning session of the Midwest Zonal Forum, tentatively scheduled to occur in the Ohio Region, but which may become a virtual meeting because a facility willing to host the forum cannot be found.
