No Employee, to the best of the knowledge of the Insured, or of any partner or officer thereof not in collusion with such Employee, has committed any fraudulent or dishonest act in the service of the Insured or otherwise. If prior to the issuance of this bond, any fidelity insurance includes of the Insured or any predecessor in interest of the Insured and covering one or more of the Insured's Employees shall have been cancelled as to any of such Employees by reason of (a) the discovery of any fraudulent or dishonest act on the part of such Employees, or (b) the giving of written notice of cancellation by the insurer issuing said fidelity insurance, whether the Surety or not, and if such Employees shall not have been reinstated under the coverage of said fidelity insurance or superseding fidelity insurance, the Surety shall not be liable under this bond on account of such Employees unless the Surety shall agree in writing to include such Employees within the coverage of this bond.

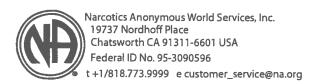

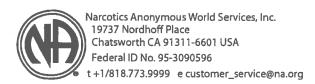
