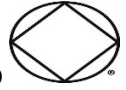

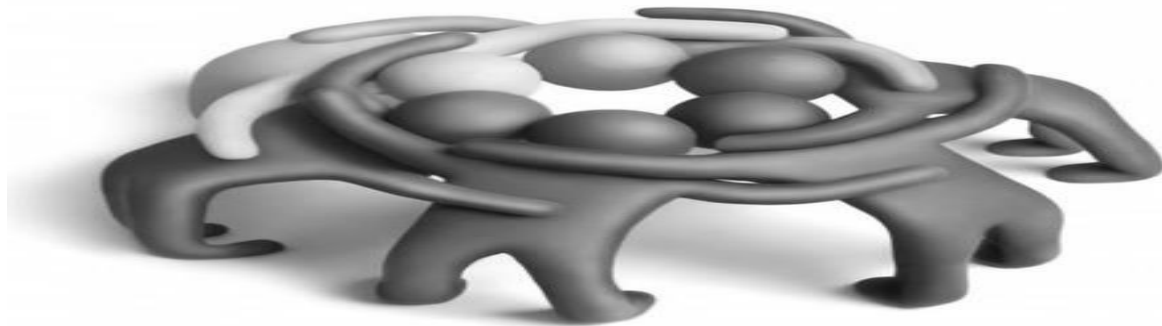

PR Survey

The NA Fellowship has gotten a lot of positive attention for our rapid response to the Covid-19 shut-downs. A couple of researchers, who have been great allies to NA, reached out to us to about surveying members. Their goal is to have enough data to present the story of NA's effective response to the pandemic to other professionals. This kind of research can increase the programs visibility and perceived viability to professionals who are able to refer addicts to NA.

NAWS News

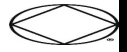

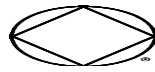
ORSCNA Motion – July 11, 2020

Since rescheduling OCNA 38 for Memorial Day Weekend 2021 the Convention Committee has recognized the COVID-19 pandemic continues to spread and surge in various parts of Ohio along with the rest of the country. It is the position of the OCNA 38 Convention Committee that social distancing guidelines which continue to change but are expected to be in effect indefinitely, make it difficult and impractical to plan fundraising events to support the Ohio Convention and ensure adequate registration and attendance at Kalahari Resort next Spring. The OCNA Advisory Committee submits this motion that ORSCNA accept the OCNA 38 Convention Committee decision to terminate all planning meetings and activities related to the Ohio Convention and cancel the event at Kalahari next year. The Convention Chairperson and Committee will coordinate with OCNA AC to inventory and audit all materials and funds accumulated so far and turn them in ORSCNA for safekeeping and redistribution in the future. Receiving a refund for the deposit from the Hotel site and making refunds for Convention registrations is on-going and could take several weeks or more but should be completed by next Regional meeting.
