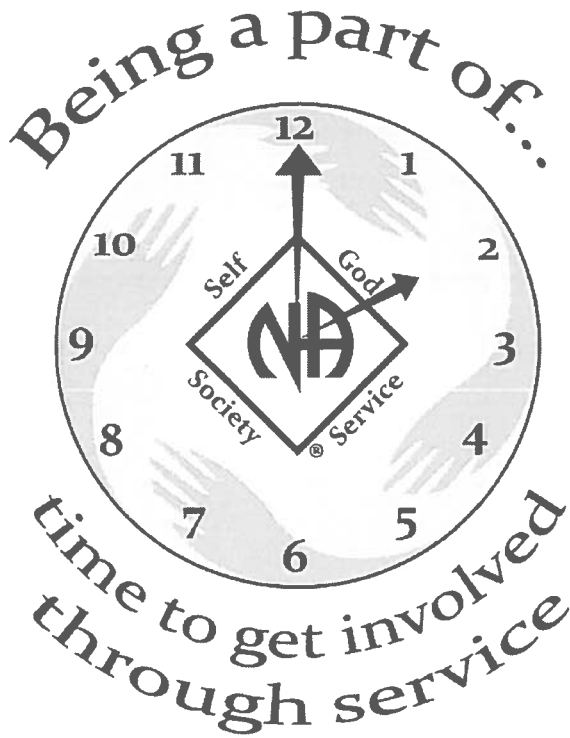
Meetings of the MZF rotate throughout participating regions and are open to all Narcotics Anonymous members.
