- · OLD BUSINESS:
- PR subcommittee had revised a letter to a Miss Aden at WZAK to see if WZAK would put a Public Service Announcement on the Air and if it would be feasible for AREA LEGS. Walt Mc. and Andre C put in a call to WZAK to see if Ms Aden was still the Integrated Marketing Specialist at the station and was told she no longer held that position. We left a message and was contacted by a David Simmons, who was in that marketing position presently. He advised us of all the different stations that they service for our area and what the best times and prices were for each of the time segments. He stated they also have a Digital Banner Service. He quoted pricing from \$50 to \$175 per announcement. We ended the call and stated it's something we would have to take a closer look at.
