We discussed issue of the Chair having an opinion during the ASC meeting. Although at a previous meeting we had conscious **not** to change the ASC Chair's guidelines, a member brought the discussion back to Policy stating what the committee voted on was not what he was discussing. He said that the Chairs guideline #1 & 2 conflicted with Concepts.

The conscious vote of the Policy Committee remains that the Chair's Guideline will not be changed at this time

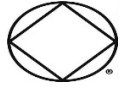

The voting regarding the issue took place on December 1, 2021. Which means the first minutes it would be reported in would be December 12, 2021, as it was.

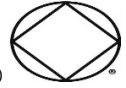
My recording of the Wednesday meetings is summarized along with the monthly minutes for reporting at the ASC meeting each month.

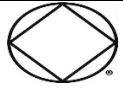

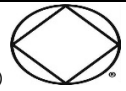
GROUP REPORT:NAME: HAPPY JOYOUS AND FREE

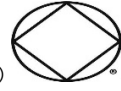
