

JULY 10,

- We opened the meeting with a moment of silence and the NA Service Prayer.
- Twelve Traditions read by Phillip H.
- Twelve Concepts read by Antoinette B.
- One minute application of the Eleventh Step.
- Subcommittee Purpose and Guidelines read by Ruby K.
- Old Business
  - Last month's meeting minutes were read and accepted.
- New Business
  - Discussion pertaining to H&I - What makes an addict a member of the H&I Subcommittee? - The confliction within the H&I Subcommittee's overall Guidelines are Subcommittee Meetings: "Membership should consist of regular participants of traditional NA meetings. The meeting should be held in a neutral site, guideline #10 [H&I] Only H&H members can vote on H&I business. [Past presedence has shown that only the following were able to vote: Vice Chair, Secretary, Literature Distributor, Facility Chairs and Substitute Facility Chairs. This would also be in confilct with the ASC Guideline #25 since to date currently no GSR is directly a part of the H&I Subcommittee.
- What the specifics does the bond purchased cover -it was not available to review.
- We discussed the audit for the Treasurer being past due and items not available from previous Policy Chair/2021, Ruby will make contact to hopefully get the items she has and any records of what the ASC Chair did this current year, we want to be able to start this process by August 2022, this would also cover the newly elected interim Treasurer [at the beginning of term.
- The Activities Subcommittee Chair was informed to they need to purchase a 888-GET HOPE Stamp for Literature since it it in their guidelines to stamp all

literature. It was also mentioned that we are still updating the newly named Activities/Entertainment Guidelines and when completed they would be post to the website for “Area Review”

- We discussed ASC Guideline #18 and the potential days are September 24<sup>th</sup> and October 8<sup>th</sup> the number of Trusted Servants was not determined but we did conscious each section covered would be up to 15 minutes.
