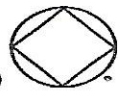

The Committee went over the Area L.E.G.S. Treasurer's Guidelines and paid close attention under the Duties section, in particular 3a which states that All financial transactions are to be handled by check or money order.

We all discussed and agreed that this style of banking should be updated for the following reasons, number one reason that online or digital banking, is more convenient, the second reason being that mail is being stolen and checks are being white washed and reused to commit theft from checking accounts, and last but not least ,digital and online banking is more secure and every transaction is automatically recorded on the account ledger as each transaction is processed. 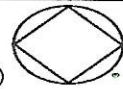
