Procedure #7 and #8:

#7 – To Table: A main motion may be tabled by GSR's. A second is required. Only one pro/con is allowable. A majority vote is required. Member may not interrupt person holding the floor and must be recognized by the Chair.

#8 – Take from Table: A tabled motion may be taken from the table by a GSR. A second is required and it is not debatable. A majority vote is required. Member may not interrupt the person holding the floorand must be recognized by the Chair.
