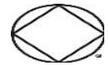


AREA L.E.G.S. MINUTES – NOVEMBER 21, 2021

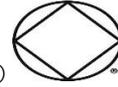

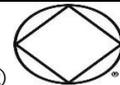

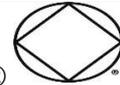

New business: Prepare to attend learning day Nov. 28, 2021.

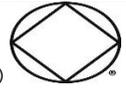
