- Update to section "Types of Transactions", sub section "Account Access at Automated Teller Machines" regarding: You may access your Home Equity Line of Credit or Personal Line of Credit for balance inquiries and making a payment to the respective line of credit at the ATM. Customers with a Debit or ATM card that have accessed a Home Equity Line of Credit or a Personal Line of Credit through the expedited card access feature, cash withdrawal, and debit card and transferring from the Home Equity Line of Credit or Personal Line of Credit is no longer allowed.
